Rules Update

A fellow scouter has noticed a discrepancy between the derby rules given out at the last pack meeting and those listed in the derby car kit insert.

After looking over the pack rule number 11 and taking some of my own measurements, rule 11 should read as follows:

11. Width shall not exceed 2 3/4 inches when measured from the outer edge of the wheels and shall not be narrower than 1 3/4 inches when measured from the inner edge of the wheels.

This will only effect your car design if you've changed the width of the wood block supplied in the kit. If you've kept the width of the block the same, you're good to go once you've slapped on the wheels. I don't know of anyone changing the width but, if you have and the car doesn't meet the above specs, send me an email and the Pack will provide you with a new kit.

Additionally, there is a small change in the way we are going to do things this year. I was going to wait until the January pack meeting to mention this but, I'm sending out an email concerning the measurements so I may as well mention it now. As rule seven indicates, in previous years the four "houses" which competed for the derby trophies were made up by randomly placing each scout in one of the four houses. This ensured that an even number of scouts were competing for the three trophies in each house since there was an uneven number of boys in each rank. This year, since the number of scouts can be broken up by rank into four groups (or houses) relatively evenly, the four houses will be made up by rank as follows:

- House 1 Tigers
- House 2 Wolves
- House 3 Webelos den 1 and 6
- House 4 Webelos den 2 and 3.
